

The cultural-linguistic mediation in Samifo Center is guaranteed by Centro Astalli, Roma Capitale and some other projects based on Regional and FAMI funds.

The strategy of assistance is based on the implementation of inter-disciplinary and intercultural healt-care paths. It is also provided by a general practitioner service and a specialistic medical service an individual support specifically for physical, psychic and social sickness, illness or disease.

Samifo team is composed by family doctors, psychiatrists, psychologists, nurses, social workers, midwives and a gynecologist of the Public Health Service, the Primary Care System and of Centro Astalli, all of them are specialized on integration and asylum issues and policies.

At the Samifo Center it is possible to carry out different post-graduate internships, in particular the Specific General Practitioner Training Course.

Samifo Center is open every day from Monday to Friday from 8.30 a.m. to 5 p.m.

THE SERVICE IS ORGANIZED UNDER THE FOLLOWING ACTIVITY LINES:

A Front Office: A reception desk providing socio-health orientation

A Back Office: A free access safe space where the privacy is guaranteed.

A cultural-linguistic structured service (not a call service) for the following languages: Farsi, Dhari, Tigrino, Amharic, Wolof, Bambara, Djoula, Mandinga, poular, Pidgin, Arabic, English, French, Somali, Urdu, Pashtu, Chinese, Bangla, Kurdish Sorani and Spanish.

Gynaecology and midwife clinic (female team only).
